

Swine Flu Update at Yeovil College ...

Yeovil College continues to operate as normal during the holiday period and we expect term time to start as normal. If you are aged between 16-19 and are hoping to start a full time course or apprenticeship in September, please turn up on your designated enrolment day as normal (this letter should have been sent to you in advance) between 28th August – 4th September 2009.

However, If you suspect you may have contracted swine flu, or have a confirmed case, please stay at home and call our Customer Liaison and Enrolment team on **01935 423921**.

It is very important that you notify us if you are unable to attend your interview. Applications for courses this year have been extremely high, so in order to confirm your place for September you should call the Customer Liaison and Enrolment team and supply evidence of your GCSE results.

If you are planning on enrolling for a part time course starting in September, course start dates are as planned. Please enrol as usual over the phone, in person, or by post, or attend our Part time and HE Enrolment Event on Tuesday 8th September 4 pm – 7.30 pm.

If you are unable to attend the first night of your classes due to a confirmed or suspected case of swine flu – once again, please notify our Customer Liaison and Enrolment team as soon as possible.
