

Fire Emergency and Security Systems Apprenticeship programme



The Course:

The Fire Emergency and Security Systems Apprenticeship at Yeovil College is taught by industry experts, who combined have over 40 years of experience as an Electrician, Engineer and Project Managing, 27 of those years in the Security Industry.

This is a three year apprenticeship, attending college on planned block weeks. Over the three years the Apprentice will study the full range of applications associated with fire and security, learning the associated skills, knowledge and behaviours. These include Applying and implement system design, planning, installation, testing, commissioning and handover. Carrying out preventative and corrective maintenance, diagnosis and repair faults, of fire detection and alarm, and other emergency systems and components, Intruder and holdup alarms, Access Control, video surveillance (CCTV) and other electronic security systems and components.

What the College will do:

We will teach the Apprentices the basics of how to become an Engineer in the industry adding to the knowledge they gain on site. We teach in block weeks - 10 weeks in year 1, 6 in year 2 and 4 in year 3 testing them for the end point assessment

We will ensure your apprentice has the tools for the end point assessment. We have a well-stocked workshop with assigned areas for assessments. We teach in a designated classroom with the visual aids to help embed their learning.

The Employers commitment:

You give them the expertise on site and teach them how to do the job. This will amount to at least 20% or 8 hours a week. We liaise with you to ensure they are progressing well and getting the scope of work needed with quarterly visits to site.



Apprenticeship Levi:

Having a designated team for the FESS course, we can quickly help with funding queries be it through the Levi or for smaller company's advice as to their position.

Next steps:
