Good luck in the finals!

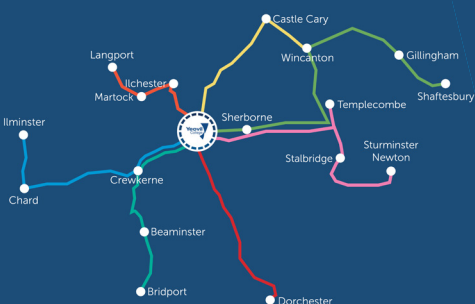


Bus Routes

Yeovil College Creative Students Produce Graduation Highlight Reel

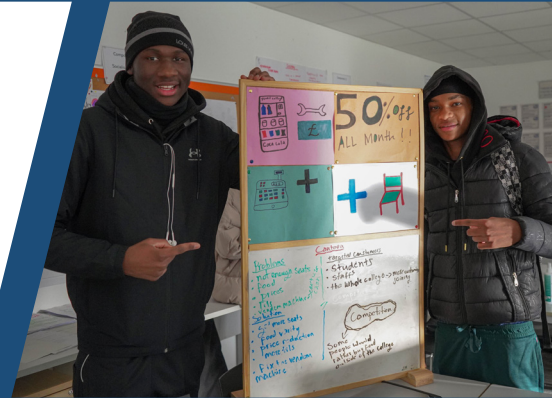
