Securing £1.9million of Funding for even more **Technological Investment**

Yeovil College has played a key strategic role in securing a significant investment for the Devon and Somerset region to address local shortfalls in skills demand, facilitated through the Local Skills Improvement Fund (LSIF).

The College has obtained £1.9million of funding to be implemented through projects in Somerset, in partnership with Bridgwater and Strode Colleges. The allocated funding will enable Yeovil College for the delivery of Engineering programmes, such as Factory 4.0. Also, a significant amount is being used to support new developments in virtual reality (VR), augmented reality (AR), mixed reality (MR), and extended reality (XR). course, careers.
