GUEST SPEAKER:

Dr Edd Goddard

Edd is the Head of Technology and Innovation at Leonardo Helicopters in the UK, part of the wider global Technology and Innovation organisation. Edd is responsible, in the UK, for setting innovation strategy, directing investment and overseeing a team responsible for delivery in Leonardo and the wider UK network. Prior to this, Edd held Leonardo management roles, responsible for technology delivery in Mission Systems, Synthetic Environments and with experience as a manager in Market Development.

Previously Edd worked with a national engineering consultancy, with responsibility for a research team and investment due diligence for new areas of technology for client organisations across the UK. This included further study as part of an industrial doctorate at the University of Bristol in the management of risk for engineering firms engaged in technological innovation. He started his career in engineering as a trainee Technologist at Leonardo and studied for a Masters in Electrical and Electronic Engineering at the University of Bath.

Mark began teaching Graphic Design in 1995 in the North East of England and continued to develop his work in the sector in the following years until he was promoted to Head of Creative Industries in 2003. Mark joined the senior team at Northumberland College in the Northeast with a focus on teaching and learning and working with the business community over the next few years until he joined the Principalship team as Assistant Principal for Teaching and Learning and then subsequently for Apprenticeships and Business Development. Mark continued with the same focus at Yeovil College, from 2015, where he led the strategic direction of curriculum and engagement with our business community. Mark was appointed as the Vice Principal for Curriculum and Quality at Yeovil College in March 2018. He took on the role of CEO & Principal at Yeovil College in October 2019.

THE OPEN UNIVERSITY PARTNERSHIP

Yeovil College is set to receive support from The Open University

Yeovil College is amongst the first wave of colleges in England that will receive support from The Open University (OU) to develop their higher technical educational offer.

Yeovil College will receive specialist support from the OU throughout the next three years to expand the number of higher education courses available in their local communities.

Backed by £10 milion of UK Government funding, the OU will be working with colleges across England to support colleges put on a wider range of advanced technical courses, linked to local employer requirements, supporting more people to secure jobs with higher wages and grow the economy in their area.

Professor Tim Blackman, Vice-Chancellor at The Open University, said:

"Further education colleges are a critical part of their local communities. We are delighted to be working with both Yeovil College University Centre and Strode College to develop their higher education offer through new advanced technical courses.
