MONEY MATTERS

If you have found the perfect course but the cost is holding you back, then there are several ways in which we can support. Depending upon your personal circumstances, you may be entitled to significant financial support or free study.

FREE OR DISCOUNTED COURSES

If you are unemployed and in receipt of certain types of benefits, or you are aged 19-23 and studying your first full Level 1, 2 or 3 qualification, it is likely that you will be eligible for free tuition. Many Yeovil College courses will be offered completely free regardless of circumstances.

19+ ADVANCED LEARNER LOAN

If you're aged 19 or over and interested in studying a Level 3 qualification or higher, then you may be eligible for help with your fees via the Advanced Learner Loan. It's easy to apply for and it does not take your household income into account, nor does it involve a credit check. Once you have been offered a place on the course, we will send you a learning and funding information letter. Repayment of the loan only starts when you are earning more than £25,000 per year.

ADVANCED LEARNER LOANS BURSARY FUND

The Advanced Learner Loan Bursary Fund supports students who have an approved Advanced Learner Loan in place and have a household income up to £45,000 to cover the fees for their course. It can be used to support costs associated with studying such as childcare, travel and hardship.

UNIVERSITY CENTRE STUDENT FUNDING

If you are a Yeovil College University Centre student, please visit Student Finance England (SFE) to clarify your financial options. SFE is a service provided by the Student Loans Company who provide financial support on behalf of the UK Government to students from England entering higher education in the UK.

ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION (HE)

The Access to Higher Education (HE) Diploma is a nationally recognised Level 3 qualification which prepares adults without traditional qualifications for study at university. The Diploma could help learners enter higher education for the first time or provide a second chance at a graduate career by giving an introduction to a different subject area, and is usually completed over one year full-time, or two years part-time.

There is no such thing as a typical Access to HE learner. Access to HE Diplomas are taken by people of all ages and backgrounds. Previous Access to HE learners have progressed onto a wide range of degree subjects at universities across the country after completing their Access courses at Yeovil College.

Financial Support for Access to HE Diplomas

For students aged 19 or over, there is loan support available under the Government's Advanced Learner Loans scheme to cover the cost of the fees. For information scan the QR code at the top of this page.

FUNCTIONAL SKILLS ENGLISH & MATHS


