<b>CURRICULUM TASTER SESSION AND DEEP DIVE DISCUSSION</b>	Small group practical taster session on YC site involving a deep dive discussion with a curriculum subject specialist.	Year 11 and Year 10.	Dependent on curriculum availability.	Yeovil College Campus.
<b>CURRICULUM CONNECTIONS PROGRAMME (LINKING TO GCSE CURRICULUM)</b>	<p>This programme can be delivered in three parts.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A subject specialist visits school site to give a talk about their own career history and careers in the industry today.</li> <li>2. Subject specialist delivers a practical session at the school, supporting a GCSE class.</li> <li>3. The GCSE class visits YC site for campus tour and taster session.</li> </ol>	GCSE classes. <b>GENERAL INFORMATION ASSEMBLY</b>	General Information Assembly at school about pathways and Yeovil College offer from either Principal, Mark Bolton, or Assistant Principal, Rob Stuckey, supported by Schools Connection Partner, Alice Parry.	Year 11 and Year 10.	For Year 11s: Ideally before Christmas, so students understand more if they come to an Open Event. For Year 10s: In the Summer Term, preparing them for next year.	School site.
<b>PATHWAYS ASSEMBLY</b>	Information Assembly at school about Post 16 pathways (A Levels, T Levels, Vocational Qualifications and Apprenticeships). Focuses on explaining that one pathway isn't better than another, but one pathway will be better for an individual, depending on learning style.	Year 11 - but content is similar to what is said during general assembly, so might work best with Year 10, Year 9 and parents.	Would work well during summer term for Year 10 and Year 9. Would work well as a talk available at a parent's evening.	School site.

<b>APPLICATION WORKSHOP</b>	YC staff visit school at a time which suits the school (lunchtime, breaktime, tutor time, etc) and have a stand where they can offer advice about courses and help students apply online on a laptop or on a paper application form. YC staff can explain the application process, steps, deadlines and benefits.	Year 11 and Year 10.	This would work best once schools have had their initial Yeovil College information assembly. YC staff can revisit in Spring term before GCSE exams for anyone who still hasn't applied for something after school, anyone who might have changed their mind and need to change their application, and Year 10s who are ready to apply early. <b>Q&amp;A SESSIONS AND INFORMATION STAND</b>	YC staff visit school at a time which suits the school (lunchtime, breaktime, tutor time, etc) and are available for students to ask questions about the application process, support, travel, YC Edge Enrichment, and careers guidance.
